

Who will be the trustees? Trustees have responsibility for directing the trust's affairs, and for ensuring that it is solvent, well-run, and delivering the trust's charitable outcomes. The DfE requires trustees to fulfil the three core functions of all governing boards, as set out in the Governance handbook [1]: setting vision, holding the headteacher to account for the school's educational performance and ensuring money is well spent.
